Subjects appropriate to the journal are physiology and biochemistry, ecology, pathology, development and morphology, systematics, cell biology and ultrastructure, genetics, molecular biology, evolution, applied aspects, and new techniques. Publication in *Mycologia* is for both members and nonmembers of the Mycological Society of America. Papers appropriate for the journal are:

- 1) regular articles reporting original research,
- 2) notes or brief articles reporting research or new techniques,
- 3) invited papers,
- 4) reviews and mini reviews.

Use "and" to search for a two word phrase, e.g., search for SMITH AND AWARD to find guidelines or the deadline for the Smith Award. Searches are not case sensitive. Items returned from the search will correspond to sections in the newsletter. The search will return the first line of any section containing the search term. Select an item on the search results list to see the full text of the section.
